Greetings and Thank You Kentucky! I am writing this on the heels of a fantastic weekend in Cave City attending the first ever Campfire and Comforters state event, which turned out fantastic! There was no formal agenda, and the weekend was intended to be a time for getting together, socializing, and some rides led by whoever put one together and wanted to lead it. My plans changed as the weekend grew closer, because I found myself behind on completing the Around the World in Kentucky Challenge. I entered the weekend still needing 10 of the 29 locations, so I planned to ride on Friday and Saturday to finish the challenge. I planned to get 7 of them on Friday and finish the last 3 on Saturday.

I held a meeting on Thursday afternoon to go over the focus of the weekend and to announce my plan to ride and finish the challenge. My plan looked like a 417-mile ride on Friday and a 158-mile ride on Saturday. I explained that I didn't expect any company of the rides, especially on Friday, because of the distance and time riding. I thought I might have some company on Saturday since I knew there were at least 2 others, who needed to get to the same 3 locations that I would be getting that day. To my surprise Joe Cain of Chapter K told me that he was going with me on Friday, and Ron Harper and Donita Nardi, of Chapter G said they would be joining me on Saturday (they are the two I was talking about). So 7 am rolled around on Friday morning and off to capture some pictures Joe and I went. Our day took us to Franklin, Oak Grove, Cadiz, Benton, Paducah, Marion, and Providence, which turned out to be 424 miles, and we were back by 5 pm in plenty of time to join the group for dinner. My thanks to Joe for keeping me company on that ride. It was a really good day.

On Saturday we had a pancake, sausage, and bacon breakfast at the campground and got ready to ride to get the remaining 3 locations. To my surprise, there were 10 bikes ready to roll. Ron, Donita, and I were joined by Randy & Kim Pommier from Chapter G, and Bruce & Kathy Hensley, Dean & Cheri Brown, Greg & Marilyn Leslie, Joe Cain & his sister Connie, and Debi Michaels from Chapter K. We had 6 Goldwing trikes, 1 Can-Am Spyder, 2 Slingshots, and my two-wheeler on the ride and we all stayed together and had a great ride, which included a really nice lunch at Angie's Family Restaurant in Albany. We returned to the campground in time for dinner after riding 166 miles.

All good things must come to an end, and we all packed up and headed for home on Sunday. There were a total of 31 members participating in this event and all indications are that we want to do it again. So, I guess we'll have to see what we can come up with and let you know.

Next up is the Blast, which is being held at the General Butler State Park August 13-15. As I write this, there is still time to get your registration in for the early discount. The price increases on August 1st, and you can always come out and get a Day Pass on site during the rally. A lot of planning and time spent preparing games, decorations, and activities go into putting on this event and our only reward is seeing a smile on your face. State Educators Report

Recently I was asked “why do I ride motorcycles?” which got me thinking. And July offered much time to think about it as I was very busy doing a lot of riding. I think for me, it is the journey more than the destination. Many times, I have reached a planned destination, only to find it looks just like it was pictured on the internet, or the magazine article. Some of the destinations of course, like the view from Mount Blue Sky, Colorado, are impossible to truly appreciate in pictures, but the overall view was the same.

What was not the same was the journey to get there. Descriptions of the ride are interpretations of the author, and each person has a different view, or presumption, or attitude, or goal, which affects their perspective and the effect on their experience. Any number of things can happen at any time during any journey. Being prepared for all of them is usually outside the scope of motorcycling but preparing for them we still must. I find there is a short list of equipment that covers a very long list of possibilities.

I am certain you know some of the equipment that I am about to recommend, and maybe even own some or all of it. A first aid kit because, well, you just never know when you or someone you meet on your journey may need exactly what you have. I have used the first aid kit I carry more times to help strangers than I have used it for myself. A good rain suit keeps you dry when the weather gets wet, and because they tend to be wind proof and offer another layer, can keep you warm when the weather turns cold, or when you climb above 12,000 feet. A small tool kit like the one Honda includes in the many variations of Gold Wing to tighten up your nuts and bolts and help you keep everything together. A tire repair kit and a small electric air pump can keep you rolling when providence is otherwise trying to flatten your mood. A small flashlight to brighten a dark moment, and a small multimeter to troubleshoot an inconvenient electrical issue. And finally, a roll of some sort of strong and sticky material to keep everything together when fasteners are missing or never existed in the first place.

When we traveled to Greenville for Wing Ding 35, I found that I needed to make a temporary repair on my brake lever to keep the brake lights functioning properly. I stopped at a convenience store and bought a small roll of duct tape, which did what I needed it to do, and we made it home without any additional drama. Over time, that roll of tape has helped several riders fix what was broken long enough to get home safely. When the last few feet were removed from the roll, I found an even better replacement product. Walmart sells T-Rex tape, a ferociously strong tape® that surprised me with its quality. This is sold as a duct tape but does not include the usual woven fibers of standard duct tape. But it is a very strong acrylic material and will stretch quite a bit to help you get a good seal on whatever odd shape you are trying to keep together. The adhesive is quite tacky and sticks strongly to a variety of smooth surfaces and is very weather resistant. If you see me on my Gold Wing, and are curious about T-Rex tape, ask me, I'll show you my roll.

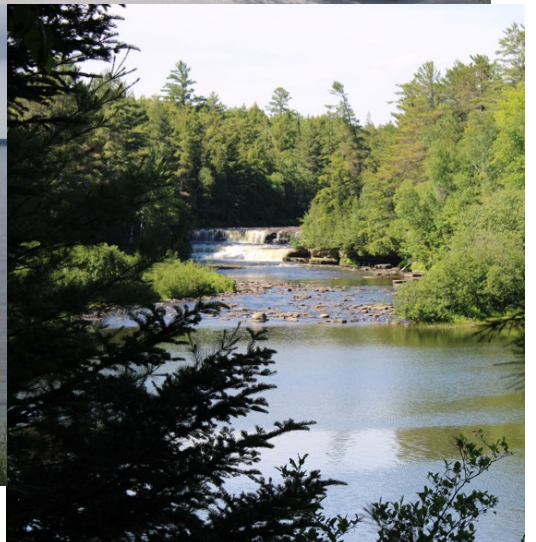

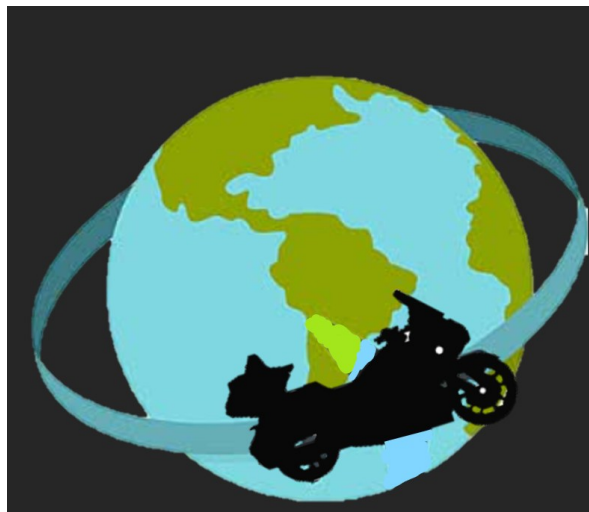
Around the World in Kentucky

Welcome to the 2026 State-wide Challenge – KRR Around the World in Kentucky! It is simple to play and hopefully includes something for everyone. Everyone who wants to participate will receive a location list of 29 Kentucky cities. Each of these cities correspond to one in another country – the countries are also included on the list. The objective of the Challenge is to visit each city and snap a picture. The specific address for the location to visit is also provided on the list. In almost all instances, it is the local post office. For those few cities that do not have a post office, an alternative location has been picked and the address for those places are included on the list. Once you reach the indicated address, simply snap a pic with your face and thumb up in front of the designated building. While this is intended to be a riding Challenge, we recognize that, for a variety of reasons, some of our KRR friends will not be riding this season or at least not as much. Therefore, please feel free to complete some or all of the Challenge in your automobile.

Once you have collected all 29 pics, email those to mepc@kyroadriders.org. If the image files are too large for a single email, feel free to send in multiple messages. Just be sure to notate the city number or numbers in the subject of each message – i.e. KRR Around the World in Kentucky Challenge - #5-#11.

The Challenge will run from the Winter Warm Up (January 30th & 31st) until midnight Saturday, August 8th. The winner will be randomly selected from all completed entries received by that date and be announced at the Blast at General Butler State Park August 13-15. Compete to win a sweet prize – a \$50 gift card – but more importantly for bragging rights. We had a good bit of participation in 2025 and are hoping for even more this year! The Challenge List will be available on the KRR Website, on the KRR Facebook Page and via email from mepc@kyroadriders.org. 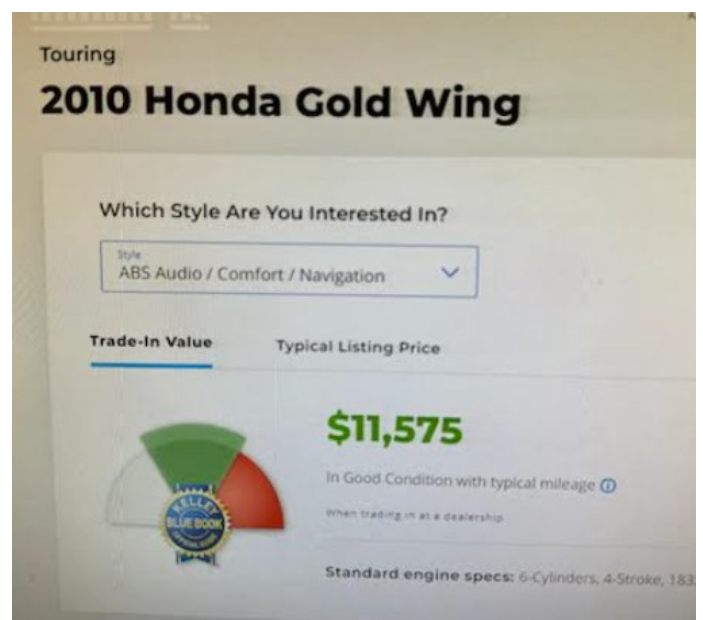

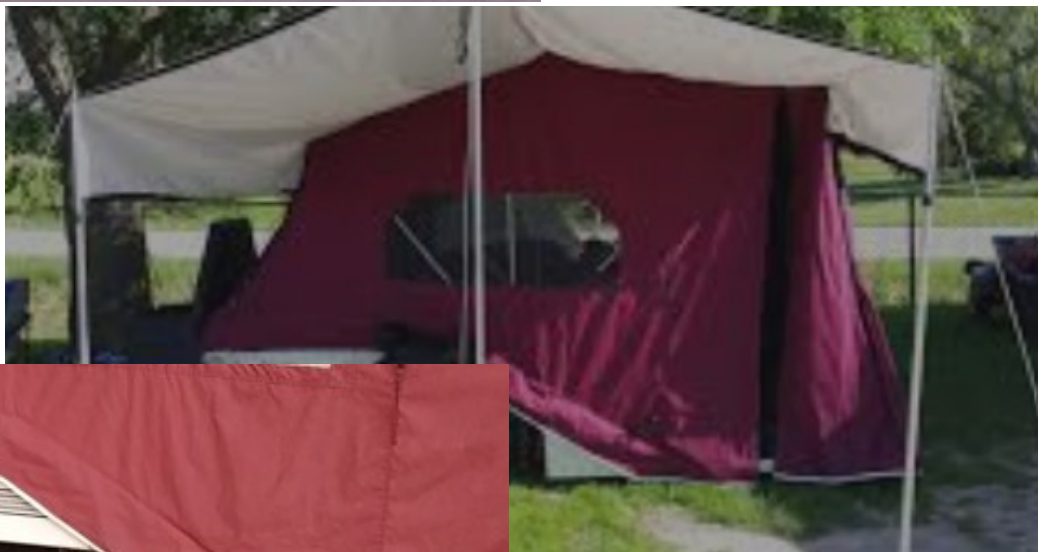

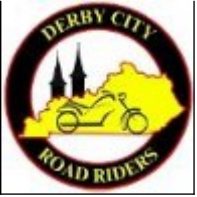
