



2026 Ride In



Woodford Reserve and Castle and Key Distilleries

Brief Description:

This ride will take you to [Woodford Reserve](#) and [Castle and Key Distilleries](#). The route will take you south of Lexington and will eventually take you to Pisgah Pike. As you get on Pisgah Pike you will pass the Kentucky Castle. Pisgah Pike will also take you past Win Star Farm which had the Derby winner in 2010 (Super Saver) and in 2018 (Justify). From Pisgah Pike you will take other scenic roads past more horse farms before arriving at Woodford Reserve.

After leaving Woodford Reserve, you will take a short ride to the Castle and Key Distillery. The parking lot is gravel so please be careful. Castle and Key was recently restored, starting in 2012 and re-opening in 2016. The distillery was originally built in 1887 as the Old Taylor Distillery. The original owner, Colonel E.H. Taylor Jr., was the first to see distilleries as a possible tourist attraction.

After visiting Castle and Key, you will make your way past more horse farms before passing through Midway and making your way to Iron works Pike where you will pass the Kentucky Horse Park and other horse farms before making your way back to the Ride In.

Ride Time: 2.5 hours

Ride In to Woodford Reserve: 1 hour and 15 minutes

Woodford Reserve to Castle and Key: 10 minutes

Castle and Key to Ride In: 1 hour and 10 minutes
